## **Organization**

The GIRO DI JERSEY is governed by the rules of USA Cycling and held under USA Cycling permit # 2010-689

## **Type of Event**

Stage Race - Conducted on Time - Lowest accumulated time over all stages is the Winner

## **Team Manager Meeting**

There will be a Mandatory Team Manager Meeting Prior to the Stage 1 Circuit Race in Trenton. NJ  
This Meeting will be held at 11:00 am in front of the staging area.

## **Participation**

Per Event requirements, Men Pro/1/2 and Women Pro/1/2/3 teams are limited to a maximum of eight riders each. 3 rider Minimum / Team

## **Rider / Team Conduct**

Any infringement of the rules and regulations applying to the race by any rider, team staff or helper will render the entire team liable to fines or disqualification.

Additional Regulations:

- a. Race officials have the ability to fine, relegate or disqualify as it relates to team and rider behavior.
- b. Indecent exposure and public urination is against both USAC and UCI regulations. Riders who are seen urinating in public anywhere outside of the designated facilities will be immediately disqualified from the event. Violators may also be subject to penalties from local law enforcement.
- c. Riders may not throw water bottles or other litter at any place other than feed zones or other designated areas. In addition to USAC/UCI penalties they may also be subject to fines from local law enforcement.
- d. Riders may not cross the finish line during a race, other than their own, that is in progress. Also, once riders have crossed the finish line they are to continue forward. Do not come backwards across the finish line and don't cross the finish line a second time.

## **Number Placement**

Two numbers must be shown for the Stage Race events. They should not be folded, trimmed, crumpled, or otherwise defaced.

There will be a \$20 replacement fee for numbers that need to be reissued.

## **Packet Pick Up**

Packet pick-up will take place from 5-9PM on June 24th at the Weston Hotel at the **Princeton Forrestal Campus Located at 201 Village Blvd. Princeton NJ 08540** the Alternative is to pick up their packets on Thursday June 25th, prior to the Corner House GP however, it is strongly encouraged that riders make every effort to pick up their packets on **Wednesday evening**. If picking up other riders' packets, you MUST present their original, ink-signed USAC waiver forms along with their licenses.

### **Stage Race - Rider Sign in Required at the Start of Each Event**

All riders must sign in before each stage. Sign-In will be located and visible at each venue, and will close 10 minutes before the start of each race.

**Sign in location will be at the registration Tent**

### **Results**

Results will be posted by the Timing and photo Finish Contractor Post Event. At or Near the sign in location. Please see attached Maps.

### **Rider Staging**

Report to the staging area at least **(20) minutes** prior to the start of your race. Last minute announcements will be made at staging.

### **Race Incidents**

A rider who suffers a mishap in the last 3K of a road stage or after free laps have expired in a crit will be given the finish time of the group he/she was in at the time of the incident but will be given his/her actual placing across the finish line. If the rider is unable to cross the finish line, the rider will be placed last.

### **Helmets**

Helmets must be worn when on the bike with the exception of rollers/trainers from the time that sign-in opens until the awards ceremonies are complete

### **Neutral Support and Wheel Pits/Vans**

**Neutral Support will be provided by Bicycle Support by Mark for the Pro 1,2 Road Race.**

**The omnium events will be supported by a wheel Van. Wheels in and out.**

## Feeding

Feeding will be allowed at the *Rocky Hill Cycling Classic Road Race For Pro 1/2, Men 3/4, and Women Pro 1/2/3*

### **Feed Zone:**

- Team representatives in the feed zones must wear a piece of team apparel that will identify them as associated with the team. There is no running in the feed zones. Riders are expected to move to the right side of the road in the feed zones to take the feed from the feeder. The feeder is not permitted to move into the peloton to deliver a feed **nor throw or toss any object to feed.**

Feed Zone of the Road Race will be located on Montgomery Road  
Infront of the Stone Bridge Sr Living Center. Please see Race Course Map

## **Time Bonus Primes - Stage Race**

### Women Pro 1,2,3

CR - 2 Point Bonus Sprints on the Finish Line.

RR - 2 Point Bonus Sprints at the summit of Old Georgetown 2nd lap and 3rd lap on the Finish Line.

CR - 2 Point Bonus Sprints at the Finish Line.

### Men Pro 1,2

CR - 2 Point Bonus Sprints on the Finish Line.

RR - 2 Point Bonus Sprints at the summit of Old Georgetown 2nd lap, 3rd lap on the finish line and the final finish

CR - 2 Point Bonus Sprints at the Finish Line.

### Men 3,4 Master 45+

CR - 2 Point Bonus Sprints on the Finish Line.

RR - 2 Point Bonus Sprints at the summit of Old Georgetown 2nd lap and on the final finish

CR - 2 Point Bonus Sprints at the Finish Line.

### Men

CR - 2 Point Bonus Sprints on the Finish Line.

RR - 2 Point Bonus Sprints at the summit of Old Georgetown 2nd lap 3rd lap on the Finish Line and the final finish

CR - 2 Point Bonus Sprints at the Finish Line.

Other than stated the Bonus Sprint laps are stated in the stage info in this document.

## Timing

Riders finishing in a group will be credited with the same time. A time split is established when there is a difference of one second or more between the back of the back wheel of one rider and the front of the front wheel of the next rider (based on UCI rule 1.2.107)

## Tie Break and Stage Time Bonuses

In the event of a tie in the general individual classification by points the following criteria shall be applied in order until the riders are separated: 1. Number of stage wins 2. Number of wins in intermediate sprints counting for the general classification on Time 3. General individual classification by time. Time bonuses will be awarded to the top three finishers in all stages

- 1<sup>st</sup>: 10 seconds
- 2<sup>nd</sup>: 5 seconds
- 3<sup>rd</sup>: 3 seconds

## Time Cut

A 20% time cut will be in effect for all categories in all stages

Riders not finishing within 20% of the winner's time will not be allowed to start the following stages.

## Lapped Riders

All riders will finish on the same lap as the leaders. The Chief Judge will calculate times for lapped riders in accordance with USAC rules and these will be the times recorded in the stage results.

- At the discretion of the race officials, lapped riders or riders in danger of being lapped may be asked to withdraw from the race. A time will be calculated as indicated in USAC rules. If the calculated time is greater than 120% of the winner's time, the rider will not be allowed to continue to the next stage/s.
- The **Rocky Hill Cycling Classic** is raced under road race rules. Riders on different laps may not assist each other and must remain separated.
- THE CORNER HOUSE GRAND PRIX AND FLEMINGTON CIRCUIT RACE raced under criterium rules. Riders on different laps are allowed to assist each other and need not remain separated. However, riders who have been lapped are not eligible for primes.

## Final Results

The final results will be based upon Individual General Classification, in accordance with USA Cycling rules.

## Stage Race Penalties

Violations of any USAC rules or regulations shall result in warning, relegation, time penalty, fine, or disqualification. The Omnium events will be held to the USAC rules and regulations.

The Pro/1/2 Men will utilize the UCI scale of penalties 12.1.040. When no fine or penalty description exists in the UCI regulations, the USA Cycling regulations shall be the default.

## Omnium Points

Omnium points will be based upon the Top 30 riders across the line in each event with point additional point bonus structure on the finish line. See stage details for info.

Omnium events are for the Men 3/4, Masters 34+, Women, and Women 4  
All riders shall wear all numbers provided by the promoter for all stages  
With the exception of time trials, all riders must sign-in before each stage.  
This is an omnium. Riders do not need to compete in all events.  
Results are based on points. Points will be awarded as follows:

Protest of results allowed until the close of sign-in for the next stage.

Ties in the final general classification will be broken by most 1<sup>st</sup> places. If still tied, most 2<sup>nd</sup> places, then most 3<sup>rd</sup> places, etc.

All penalties and fines will be in accordance with USAC rules.

## Results

- Results, communiqués and official race announcements will be posted at the race venue and and at the website once available.
- Results may be appealed until the start of the next day's stage, or until 15 minutes after results for the final stage are posted at the race venue.
- Results will also be available online at [www.girodijersey.com](http://www.girodijersey.com) at the close of each day.

## Award Ceremonies and Prizes

The top 3 finishers for each stage and the top 3 on GC, as well as the top Points leader, are required to report to the finish area immediately after the stage finish for media interviews and the Award Ceremony. Leader and Omnium Leader jerseys will be awarded and must be worn during the next stage.

Final GC awards will follow the stage awards for the Flemington Circuit Race  
Final Awards **will** be distributed after results are official. Monetary prizes will mailed to the address that you registered with with in 7 business days of the final stage.

**Riders who do not attend the Awards Ceremony or Media Interviews after their races will loose their prize money.**

## First Aid Locations

There will be first aid staff available at each stage, in addition to on site EMTs and ambulances. The location of the first aid tents can be found the stage Maps.

## YELLOW LINE RULE Rocky Hill Cycling Classic

This is a new race to the area residents. Even though we have partial course closure and Local Traffic only in a one way direction with the flow of the race, the yellow line rule will be looked at in the following way:

1. There will be no attacking from the left lane. Some of our utilized roads do not have a center line.  
Just use your brains.
- 2 There will be no advancing your position beyond the yellow line
- 3 Route 518 from the top of old Georgetown into Rocky Hill to Route 206 will be lifted of this rule.

## **(ROLLING ENCLOSURE) ROAD RACE EVENTS**

**ALL Road Race Events will Be contained in a rolling enclosure.**

**If you fall behind Neutral Support you are going on a training ride.**

**You must abide by the rules of the road and normal traffic law.**

**The officials at the line may tell you to keep riding or pull you and give you a pro-rated time.**

**If you are in an Omnium Race and fall off beyond the Wheel Van please report to the Officials Stand and pull yourself from the race. This is for your own safety and the safety of the other athletes on the road.**

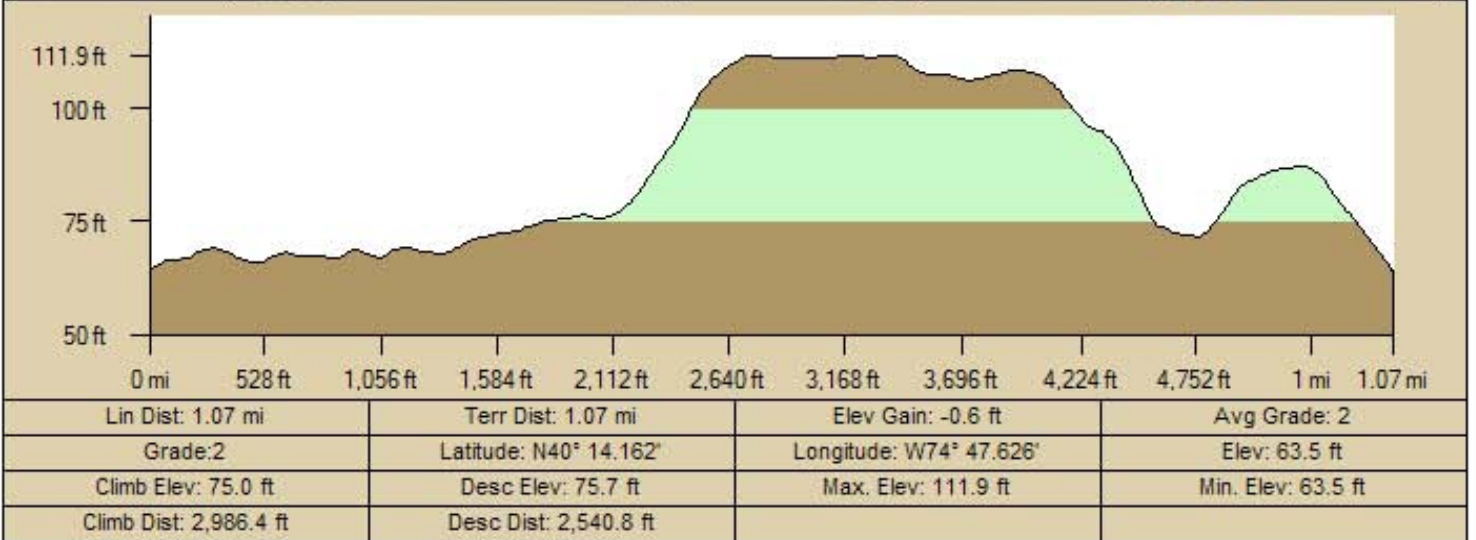

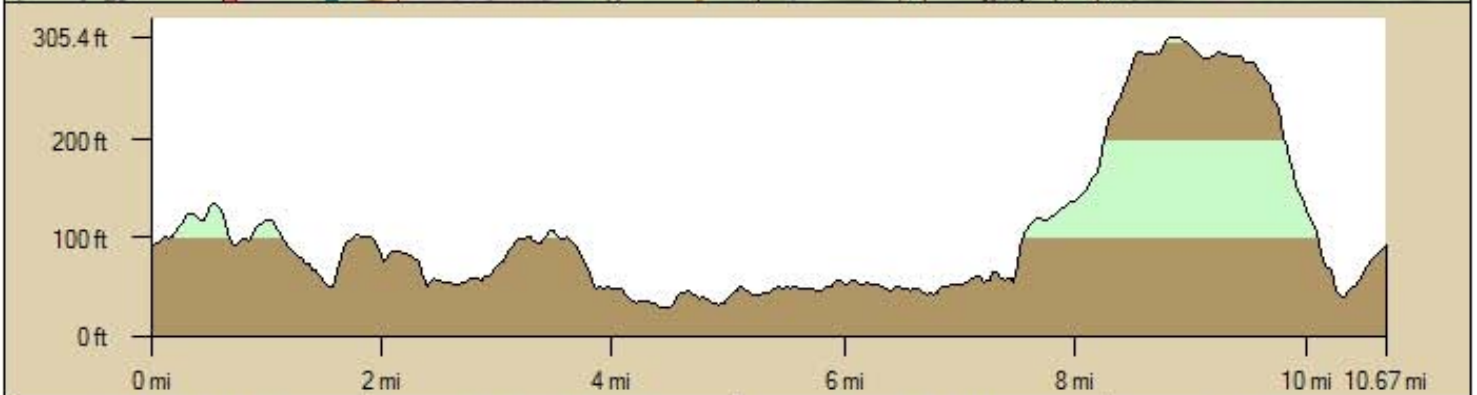
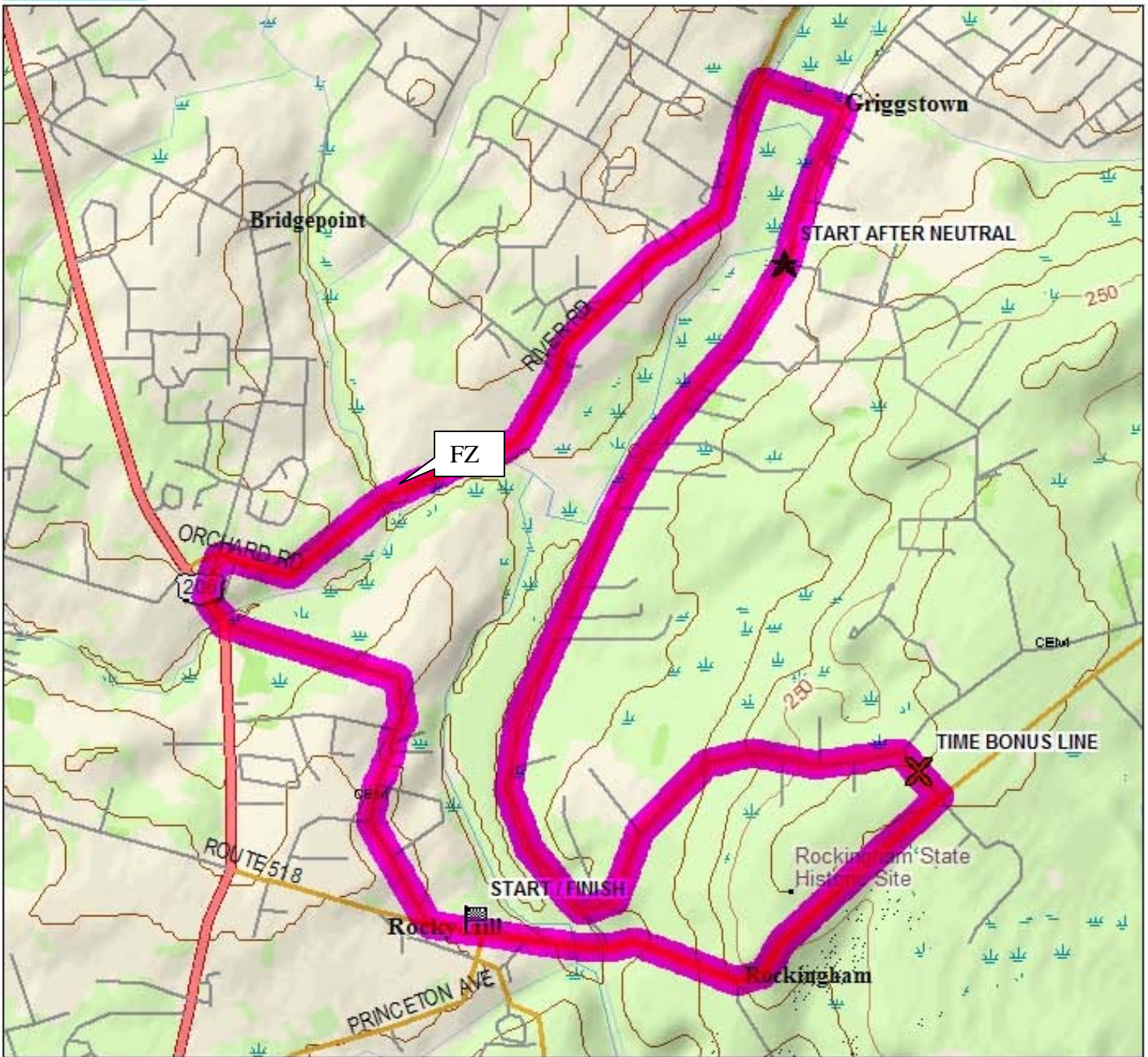

2. Merge onto I-95 S/NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE S (Portions toll).
3. Keep RIGHT to take I-95 S/NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE S toward CARS-TRUCKS-BUSES (Portions toll).
4. Merge onto I-287 N via EXIT 10.
5. Merge onto US-22 W via EXIT 14B on the LEFT toward US-202/CLINTON/US-206.
6. Merge onto US-202 S toward FLEMINGTON/PRINCETON.
7. Turn RIGHT onto CR-650/CHURCH ST. Continue to follow CHURCH ST.
8. Turn RIGHT onto MAIN ST.

### From the South

1. NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE North I-95 (Portions toll).
2. Merge onto US-206 N via EXIT 7 toward BORDENTOWN/TRENTON.
3. Turn SLIGHT LEFT onto CR-545.
4. Turn LEFT onto US-130 S.
5. Merge onto I-295 N toward TRENTON.
6. Merge onto I-95 S.
7. Take the RT-31 N exit, EXIT 4, toward PENNINGTON.
8. Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto PENNINGTON RD/NJ-31 N.
9. Enter next roundabout and take 3rd exit onto NJ-31.
10. Merge onto US-202 N/NJ-31 N toward FLEMINGTON.
11. Enter next roundabout and take 3rd exit onto NJ-12 W.
12. Enter next roundabout and take 1st exit onto MAIN ST.
